

University hosts art exhibits

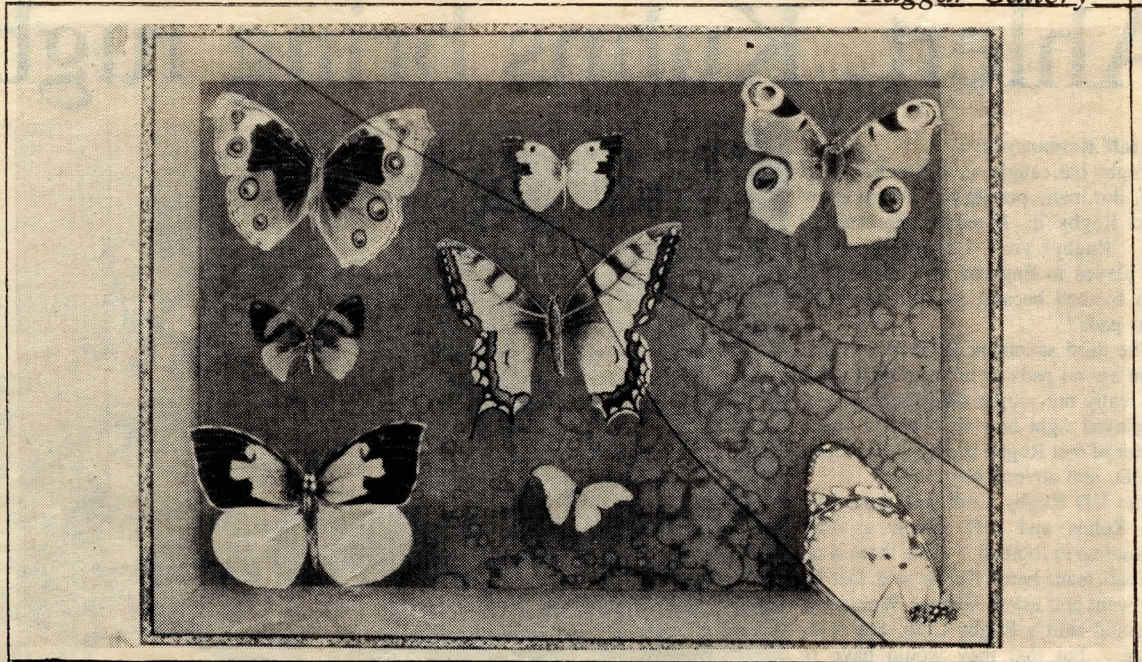

Sixty selected art works from across the country will be on display at UD's Haggerty Art Center Nov. 11-29 for the 8th UD National Print Invitational.

The 60 prints, which are the works of 20 artists, will be exhibited from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays. Later, the traveling exhibit will be shown at six other universities and museums in Texas.

Selected from more than 1,200 submitted slides, the prints originated in states ranging from Maine to California, and their arrival at UD was partially funded by the Irving Arts Board.

The print show will also be presented at Lamar University, Beaumont; Midwestern State University, Wichita Falls; Brown-Lupton Gallery at Texas Christian University in Fort Worth; Warehouse Center for the Living Arts in Corsicana; Abilene Fine Arts Museum and East Texas State University, Commerce.
